INTENDED ACTION: Amend rule.


SUBSTANCE OF PROPOSED ACTION: The State Fire Marshal is proposing to amend the rule which adopts the 2013 edition of the National Fire Codes®, with exceptions. The amendments are both from the list of those portions not adopted, one to correct a typographical error in the reference to NFPA 58 and the other to add NFPA 5000 to the list of those portions not adopted. The amendments will become effective June 24, 2017.
