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135-X-13-.01 Fees

135-X-13-.01 Fees. The fee requirements shall be set and annually adopted by the Board. The fee requirements shall be published after the last Board meeting held prior to October 1 of each year. Fees shall be charged for each of the following items:

- (1) An examination fee
- (2) An application fee
- (3) An original license fee
- (4) An emergency permit fee
- (5) A renewal fee
- (6) A late renewal penalty
- (7) A reciprocity questionnaire fee
- (8) An administrative fee
- (9) An inactive reactivation fee
- (10) Copying of records fee
- (11) A return check fee
- (12) A reapplication fee
- (13) ~~A replacement license fee~~
