


AGENCY NAME: Alabama Department of Insurance

INTENDED ACTION: Adopt new rule.

SUBSTANCE OF PROPOSED ACTION: The Commissioner of Insurance is proposing to adopt a new rule regarding processing the registration and maintaining records of persons filing registration as vehicle protection product warrantors. The new rule sets the fees for initial and annual renewal of registration at \$250 as authorized in Section 8-33-11, Code of Alabama 1975. The new rule will become effective April 21, 2019.
