



500-X-2-.15. Renewals And Expirations.

(1) Registrants will be mailed annually, during the month of November, an application for renewal of registration. This original application must be signed and returned to the Board office with the renewal fee. The registration renewal notice will contain the Code of Conduct for Landscape Architects, Rule 500-X-2-.12, which the registrant is required to read and by signature reaffirm again to abide by the Code of Conduct.

(2) The right to practice as a Registered Landscape Architect expires December 31 of each calendar year unless renewed. The right to renew expires March 15, of each calendar year. ~~To be re-registered, a registrant who does not renew before March 15, of each calendar year will be required to file a new application and meet the statutory requirements in existence at the time of re-registration.~~ To reinstate a license after March 15th, a registrant must submit the required documentation, to include CE, and reinstatement fee required for each year the license is expired. A registrant will not be eligible for reinstatement after five (5) years past the expiration date of said license.
