
SUBSTANCE OF PROPOSED ACTION:

380-X-3-.12 Inactive/Unlicensed Listing In Roster. (Repealed)

~~A person who has been a Registered Forester in the past and has allowed their license to lapse may be listed as "inactive/unlicensed" in the State of Alabama Roster of Registered Foresters for a reasonable fee determined by the Board. Those with "inactive/unlicensed" status are no longer Registered Foresters and may not practice forestry. A person who has been listed as "inactive/unlicensed" and wants to again become a Registered Forester must apply for a new license as if he or she had never received a license and must satisfy existing requirements for registration.~~
