AGENCY NAME: Alabama Criminal Justice Information Center (ACJIC)

RULE NO. & TITLE: Chapter 265-x-4. Secondary Metals Recyclers System.

INTENDED ACTION: The Alabama Criminal Justice Information Center proposes to add Chapter 265-x-4 as a rule in the Alabama Administrative Code.

SUBSTANCE OF PROPOSED ACTION: This new rule will add recently enacted requirements subject to section 13A-8-30, *et. seq.*, of the Code of Alabama, requiring for Secondary metals recyclers to submit information required by section 13A-8-31.2(b)(2) in an electronic file format as determined by the ACJIC Director. Similar "electronic" submission language currently is included in Chapter 265-x-3 of the Alabama Administrative Code, which addresses the requirement for law enforcement agencies to report Alabama Uniform Crime Reporting information to ACJIC electronically.
