By this rule, it is the specific intent that wherever the name "Alabama Department of Industrial Relations" appears in these administrative rules, it shall thereafter be substituted with the name "Alabama Department of Labor". It is furthermore the specific intent that wherever the title "Director" appears in these administrative rules, it shall thereafter be substituted with the title "Commissioner".
