
SUBSTANCE OF PROPOSED ACTION: The Appendix A contains outdated information that is no longer valid.

660-3-4-.01 Adoption By Reference Of 45 Code Of Federal Regulations, Chapter III.

The provisions of Title 45, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 301 through Part 308, such regulations being in effect June 26, 1975 through present, and all of same as may be amended, are hereby adopted by reference. The provisions implement Title IV-D of the Social Security Act (The Child Support Enforcement Program).
