INTENDED ACTION: Amend existing rule.



3 a. CGAD. The Corporate Governance Annual Disclosure.

4 b. COMMISSIONER. The Alabama Commissioner of Insurance.

5 c. INSURANCE GROUP. Those insurers and affiliates
6 included within an insurance holding company system as defined
7 in Chapter 29 of the Alabama Insurance Code, beginning with
8 Section ~~27-1-29~~ 27-29-1, Code of Alabama 1975.

9 d. INSURER. As defined in Section 27-29B-2.

10 e. NAIC. The National Association of Insurance
11 Commissioners.

12 f. SENIOR MANAGEMENT. Any corporate officer responsible
13 for reporting information to the board of directors at regular
14 intervals or providing this information to shareholders or
15 regulators and shall include, for example and without
16 limitation, the Chief Executive Officer ("CEO"), Chief
17 Financial Officer ("CFO"), Chief Operations Officer ("COO"),
18 Chief Procurement Officer ("CPO"), Chief Legal Officer
19 ("CLO"), Chief Information Officer ("CIO"), Chief Technology
20 Officer ("CTO"), Chief Revenue Officer ("CRO"), Chief
21 Visionary Officer ("CVO"), or any other "C" level executive.
