Substance of Proposed Action: To ensure that poultry imported into Alabama have been tested for Avian Influenza or originated in flocks certified being free of Avian Influenza.



(H5N2) has not been diagnosed in the area and this flock did not originate within an Avian Influenza quarantine area. (In case of doubt the certifying veterinarian shall require a negative AGID serology.)
