

Formerly Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) and Acquired Immunodeficiency Syndrome (AIDS). Significant revisions combining multiple diseases and updated statistics provided.

Updated statistics, correction of scrivener and grammatical errors.

410-2-2-.07 Substance Use Disorders

Formerly Preventable Diseases, now addressed in 410-2-2-.05. Significant revisions addressing current utilization of illicit and prescription drugs, scope of substance use expounded.

Formerly Influenza, now addressed in 410-2-2-.05.
