
INTENDED ACTION: To amend the rule

SUBSTANCE OF PROPOSED ACTION: Amend rule to clarify that if a supervising physician's Alabama Controlled Substances Certificate becomes inactive, revoked, suspended, restricted, or placed on probation, then the QACSC shall be administratively terminated by operation of law.
