NOTICE OF INTENDED ACTION

AGENCY NAME:

Alabama Peace Officers Standards and Training Commission

RULE NO. & TITLE:

Entire Chapter 650-X-12
Continuing Education Requirements

INTENDED ACTION:

Amend Chapter 650-X-12-01, -.02, -.03; Repeal -.04.

SUBSTANCE OF PROPOSED ACTION:

This action is proposed to amend the language of this chapter to comply with Code of Alabama 1975, §§36-21-40 et seq., and to further define the requirements for continuing education of a law enforcement officer. It clarifies the exemption from continuing education requirements for members of the military who are activated for more than six months due to a declared state of national emergency; and establishes the certification of officers who have been absent from law enforcement employment for more than ten years as void. In addition, Rule 650-X-12-.04, Firearms Qualification By Retired Certified Law Enforcement Officers, is repealed as a result of revisions to Federal law. Non-substantive changes related to sentence structure and grammar are made to clarify and better express the intent of the rules.


