Required Standards For Appointees As Law Enforcement Officers And For
Applicants For Certification As Law Enforcement Officers

INTENDED ACTION:

Amend Chapter 650-X-2.

SUBSTANCE OF PROPOSED ACTION:

This action is proposed to amend the language of this chapter to comply with Code of Alabama 1975, §§36-21-40 et seq., and to further define the requirements for appointment as a law enforcement officer. It clarifies the requirement that applicants for the law enforcement or correctional training academy pass a basic abilities test approved by the Commission; and an applicant's eligibility based on character related issues. Non-substantive changes related to sentence structure and grammar are made to clarify and better express the intent of the rules.


