The Alabama Board of Examiners in Counseling proposes to add a new rule to allow some exceptions to licensure requirements for those on active duty military or the spouse of someone who is on active duty in the military.

SUBSTANCE OF PROPOSED ACTION:


The proposed new rule will authorize the board to accept alternative means of verification as well as grant exceptions for some requirements for licensure to those persons who are active duty military or the spouse of someone who is on active duty in the military.
