NOTICE OF INTENDED ACTION

RULE NO. & TITLE: 262-x-4-.02 Eligibility Criteria Generally.


INTENDED ACTION: Amend

SUBSTANCE OF PROPOSED ACTION: The Commission proposes to amend the rule to remove the requirement that the crime victims' compensation application be notarized. The proposed amendment would also allow facsimile signatures or electronic signatures for the crime victims' compensation application. It also allows for the submission of copies of proof of legal presence instead of original or certified copies of proof of legal presence.
