

SUBJECT: AMENDMENT TO THE ALABAMA STATE PLAN FOR MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

The Alabama Medicaid Agency is proposing to amend its State Plan for Medical Assistance through a State Plan Amendment. This amendment will increase the Current Asset Values for Nursing Homes to account for increased costs of Nursing Homes. This amendment also provides parameters for the Quality Incentive Add-On Payment to Nursing Homes.

The effective date of this State Plan Amendment will be October 1, 2020. The estimated increase in expenditures for this State Plan Amendment is estimated to be \$18,000,000 for 2021.

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
SUBJECT: AMENDMENT TO THE ALABAMA STATE PLAN FOR MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

The Alabama Medicaid Agency is proposing to amend its State Plan for Medical Assistance. This State Plan Amendment will allow the Alabama Medicaid Agency to apply the reimbursement basis for inpatient and outpatient hospital services for State fiscal year 2021 (Medicare and cost, respectively) used in fiscal year 2020.

The effective dates of this State Plan Amendment will be October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2021. The estimated increase in expenditures for this State Plan Amendment is estimated to be \$189,321,658.
